Spiritual, Moral, Social, Cultural

Spiritual

RE (Religious Education) - This is delivered through religious education lessons through the Salford Agreed Syllabus (See separate document)

P4C (Philosophy for Children) & British Values – This is used as a way to teach children to recognise right and wrong; respect the law; understand consequences; investigate moral and ethical issues; offer reasoned views and have an appreciation of British values in assemblies.

Social

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health, Economic Education) – through the implementation of our Jigsaw curriculum (See separate document)
